

Sony Reader Borrowing Form

Readers can be borrowed for a maximum of 7 days, after which time if the Reader is not returned, students will accrue a \$5 per day late fee.

Any Reader not returned within 14 days will be declared lost, and the student will be responsible for the cost of replacement (\$200 for the device and \$50 to cover all other costs of replacement: warranty, shipping, tax). If the device is in any way damaged, lost, or stolen, the student may be required to pay for the cost of replacement as stated above (\$250).

Students may request a title be loaded on the Reader in addition to the existing books on the device. The librarian may deny this request if: the title already exists in the regular collection, if the title is not WWVA appropriate, and if the title is too expensive.

Students may not load any material onto the device while in their possession without oral consent of the librarian.

Students will be instructed on how to operate and care for the Reader while it is in their possession. Some general precautions:

Don't use the Reader near food or beverages.

The USB cord must be inserted carefully into the Reader.

The Reader shouldn't be left in a vehicle or unsupervised area.

The Reader shouldn't be kept in your backpack where it can be damaged by heavy items.

Always return the Reader to its case after use to protect the screen.

Do not set books or anything else on the Reader. It may crack the screen.

Again, you may not download items without librarian consent.

By signing, the parent and student agree to the above requirements, and are responsible for the replacement cost of the device (\$250) if it is lost, stolen, or damaged.
